Undivided

In 2 Peter 1:20-21 we learn that the Bible is not man's interpretation of what God said. God inspired the Bible and therefore there cannot be any errors.

The Bible is the standard that everything we say and do is measured against. No other work or published book is on par with the Bible.

Hebrews 4:12 “For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.”
